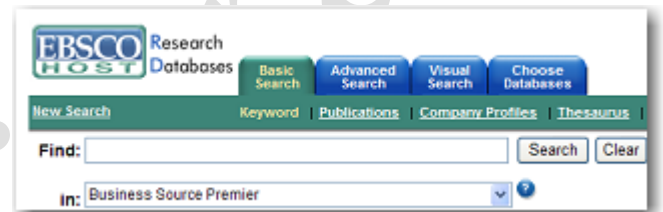




Searching for Business Information

“**Business Source Premier**”, an EBSCO database is the premier tool for business and company information.

- Connect to **Blackboard**
- Click on the **Library** tab
- From the library home page click on the database and go to the list of **Business products**
- Select from the list
- From the main screen, you can search for magazine or journal articles about a business topic by using the basic search screen.
- Enter your topic in the box provided
- Click search to retrieve articles



Search tips

Phrases should be placed in quotes

* can be used to find words with a common stem economics, economic, economical econom*

Combine two words together with an AND IBM and history

Combine two like words together with an OR supervisor or employer

ft y searches for only full text articles

Parenthesis can be used to help determine the order of search terms
